California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Process

A well application or a well permit that has been issued is required to go through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) process when the review is no longer ministerial and requires a variance from the well ordinance. A few examples but not limited to are: not meeting well setbacks from animal/fowl enclosures, septic and leach lines, or requesting an annular seal depth less than the minimum requirement.

- 1. Contractor/Applicant informs Tulare County Environmental Health (TCEH) that they are going through CEQA process so that the application can be entered into the Planning and Land Management System (PALMS), assigned a Water Well Application number (WWA#) and placed in a pending status. Prior to assigning a WWA@, a letter from the applicant and contractor is needed to explain why the variance is being requested as well as the mitigation measures that will be taken. - 2. Contractor/Applicant completes two (2) documents: RMA Discretionary Application and Indemnification Agreement. Any non-relevant questions can be responded to with an n/a. https://tularecounty.ca.gov/rma/planning-building/planning-and-land-use-applications-and-forms/major-discretionary-projects-application/

In the Discretionary Application provide the Water Well Application number or the permit number if one has been assigned.
